



Acting Beach Captain

Supervised By: Beach Captain

Subordinates: Lifeguards employed at their site when acting as Beach Captain

Job Summary

Under the direction of the Beach Captain, an Acting Beach Captain is responsible for beach operations at their assigned beach location in the Beach Captain's absence. The Acting Beach Captain also fulfills job requirements of a Lifeguard in the Beach Captain's presence.

Job Duties

1. Assumes responsibility for the supervision of beach patrols in the Beach Captain's absence.
2. Assists the Area Supervisor in his/her duties as requested.
3. Assumes responsibility for the proper conduct and performance of the duties of guards under his/her supervision in the Beach Captain's absence.
4. Directs and assigns daily tasks and inservice training in the Beach Captain's absence.
5. Ensures proper daily documentation of statistics in the Beach Captain's absence.

Job Specifications

1. NLS Surf/Waterfront Option.
2. Standard First Aid with BLS level C (NSOH&S recognized).
3. One season with NSLS or equivalent experience.
4. NLS/SFA/CPR Instructor/Examiner certification preferred.
5. A thorough understanding of NSLS policies and procedures.
6. A high degree of mental alertness for long periods of time.
7. Successful completion of the physical fitness-screening test
8. All NSLS Employees 18 years of age and over will undergo a Criminal Records Check.

Working Conditions

Eight hour shifts, 40-45 hours weekly. Hazards associated with outdoor aquatic environment and of rescuing drowning victims (e.g. sun, inclement weather, dangerous water conditions)
